When you come, please bring the following:

- Copy of last year's tax return - This is very important this year!
- Evidence of health insurance - Medicare, employer, supplemental, exchange
- W-2, SSA-1099, 1099-R forms
- All 1099 forms (1099INT, 1099DIV, 1099B, etc) showing interest and/or dividends and documentation showing original purchase price of sold assets
- Any 1099MISC forms showing miscellaneous income
- All forms indicating federal and/or state income tax paid
- Unemployment compensation statements
- Dependent care provider information (name, employer ID, Social Security number)
- All receipts or cancelled checks if itemizing deductions
- Social Security cards or other official documentation for yourself and dependents
- A photo id

* All our volunteers are IRS trained and certified every year.

* There is never a fee or sales pitch for other services. AARP membership is not required

* The program is open to taxpayers of all ages and backgrounds.
