- Students in grades 3-5
- Up to 250 words or 1 page typed
- Clearly title your story at the top of the page
- DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON YOUR COMPLETED STORY. YOU MUST INSTEAD FILL OUT AN ENTRY FORM AND ATTACH IT TO YOUR STORY.
- Must summit by October 25th to the service desk in the Lodewick Children's Library
- One entry per person
- Winner(s) receive a Gift Certificate to Books on the common
- Depending on entry numbers, multiple winners may be selected
- Winners will be announced at our Scary Stories Book Party on Monday, October 28th from 4:30-5:30 pm. Please register for that event separately.
